

Building Commissioner

The town of Wenham is accepting applications for the position of Building Commissioner. This full-time position will take a leadership position in the newly created regional inspectional service program of Wenham and Hamilton. This position will be responsible for the interpretation and enforcement of all building and related codes including electrical, plumbing and gas, zoning bylaws, and other applicable laws, regulations, codes and bylaws, and will serve as the Zoning Enforcement Officer in both municipalities. Must have a bachelor's degree in a field related to building construction or design, or master craftsman level of trade knowledge; 10 years of supervision of building construction or design experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the essential functions of the job. Prior municipal inspectional experience preferred. Must possess and maintain State Construction Supervisor's License and State Certification as a Building Official and as a Building Commissioner, or ability to obtain State Certification as Commissioner within two years as required by G.L. c. 143, §3. Starting pay for this 40 hour/week position ranges from \$26.28 to \$32.84/hour, depending on qualifications.
